

The DAC's 2024 MyColony Mouse per diem Rate (effective July 1, 2023) includes the first \$0.04/cage increase required to cover the cost of MyColony services. Another \$0.04/cage will be added to the MyColony rate next fiscal year. Cages ordered directly from an approved commercial vendor will be charged the 2024 Standard Mouse per diem.
